The first five books of the Bible (Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy) form the most sacred text in Judaism, the Torah, which serves as the foundation from which the rest of Scripture finds its footing. Over the course of the next three years, Pastor Brent will walk us through the Torah and help us engage the stories, explore the mysteries, notice things we've never noticed before, and wrestle with their meaning while paying attention to the historical, cultural, and social contexts in which they were written.

The Lectionary Bible Study gathers in person to read, study, and reflect on the passage of Scripture that Pastor Brent will be preaching on the following Sunday.
